Rules of nomination:

1. Photo was taken in North America (Canada, United States or Mexico)
2. Photo has been freely and widely shared on social media
3. Photo has impacted the movement in some way (i.e., spurred action or emotion, used in an educational presentation or video, picked up by the press, etc.)
4. The identity of the photographer is known and permission has been given to share.
5. Photo is submitted to cindy@homesforhorses.org by 5pm EDT on Monday, July 31.
